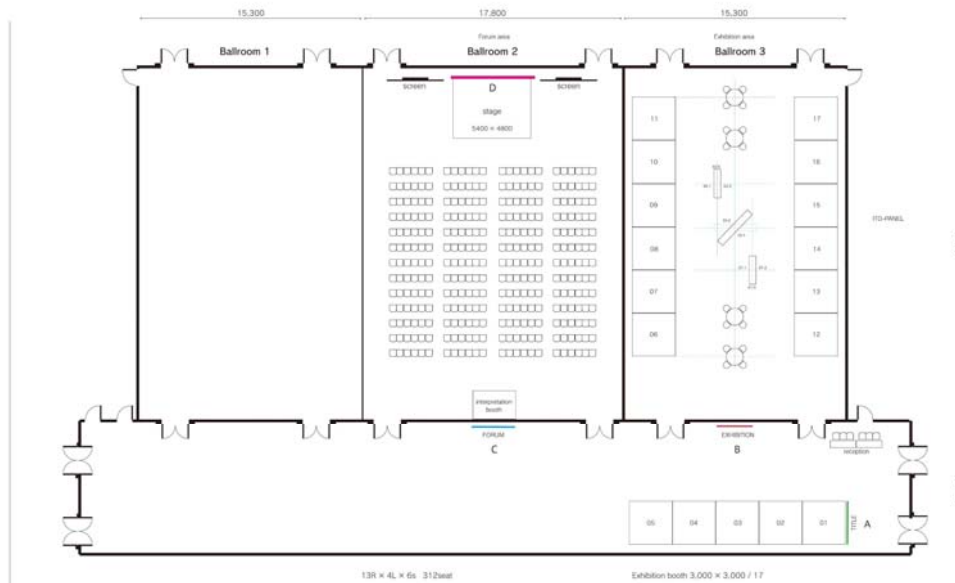

Opening Address - Yoshiaki Ogura JSB President

JSB President Yoshiaki Ogura Opening Address

*The President of Indonesia Institute of Architects Mr. Ahmad Djuhana,
Ambassador Masafumi Ishii of Japan Embassy of Indonesia,
Ladies and gentlemen,
Today, we are delighted to hold this forum with many help and effort from all of you.*

This forum was held in cooperation by the Indonesian Institute of Architects, the Ministry of Land, Infrastructure, Transport and Tourism of Japan and five architectural organizations. I am extremely grateful for the cooperation.

In addition, we are joined by one of the most famous architect from Japan, Mr. Toyo Ito, and from Indonesia, Mr. Rachmat Gobel, the President's Investment Envoy to Japan, and Mr. Radwan Kamil, Mayor of Bandung, for the keynote lecture. After keynotes lectures, panel discussion with them are scheduled.

I would like you to expect meaningful and useful exchange of opinions from this talks on architecture and urban development.

Our country, Japan, have encountered and have a history of enduring various natural disasters such as earthquake, tsunami, fire, typhoon, etc., and recent man-made disaster recently occurred, nuclear power plant meltdown. Among them, we have accumulated many building construction techniques and management methods.

We also experienced sudden urbanization, which began with the postwar reconstruction, and the infrastructure development accompanying it, and we are acquired many skills on these issues as well.

Your country shares common natural environment with Japan. Earthquakes, tsunamis, and hot and humid, rainy environments are common environments of both countries.

And now in Indonesia housing development and town planning are progressing with infrastructure development, but at the same time we are asking that we have to solve various environmental problems.

In the process of solving such problems, in order to find the best results, we believe that mutual collaboration between people in charge of resolution is necessary. In such a meaning, I decided to submit "CROSS COLLABORATION" as the sub-theme of today's forum.

This forum is continued to be held starting from Singapore, Hanoi, Ho Chi Minh and this time in Jakarta as the 4th time. As we hold the event over the time we deepened the relationship between local and Japanese architects, constructors, building materials manufacturers.

I hope that this forum will be a fruitful to you all and to us.

Next year in 2018, the Japan Institute of Architects will host ARCASIA, event where architects from 21 Asian countries gather in one place, and this time it is in Tokyo.

It will be the first time for ARCASIA conference to be held in Japan, and our activities here are also related to this movement. I would like to support the ARCASIA

conference so that the architectural world of our country will be able to serve even more Asian countries,

We proudly invite you to participate in the ARCASIA conference in Tokyo next year and have you see the current situation of the cities of Tokyo and other cities in Japan and I hope that you can refer to future city planning and infrastructure improvement in your local cities.

VIP Guest - Ambassador Masafumi Ishii of Japan

Ambassador Masafumi Ishii Greetings

Thank you very much for inviting me to the Japan - Indonesia Architecture Forum 2017 today. I would like to congratulate from the bottom of my heart. Also, I would like to express my gratitude to the Japan Supporting Board for Global Activities of Architecture for hosting this seminar at this most appropriate timing.

Japan and Indonesia will keep intimate relations since the establishment of diplomatic relations in 1958 and will celebrate the 60th anniversary of diplomatic establishment next year.

Between the two countries, we have held six summit meetings, including four mutual visits, in about three years since president Djoko took office in October 2014. In order to further strengthen the strategic partnership between the two countries, the two leaders will promote trade and investment in the economic field including cooperation of human resource development, in addition to ocean field / political field, infrastructure through port development and railway improvement, and promotion on the energy development. We have both agreed to deepen cooperation in a wide range of areas.

In terms of economic aspects, the amount of direct investment from Japan to Indonesia last year has doubled from the previous year to 5.4 billion dollars, and it is increasing its presence. (Reference: First half of 2017: \$ 2.85 billion)

Among them, in the urban development and housing field, Japanese companies have made many investments, such as industrial park development in the eastern part of Jakarta, Senayan development by Kajima Corporation that has a presentation after this, and BSD development in recent years.

Furthermore, with the remarkable economic development of Indonesia in recent years, more and more Japanese-affiliated developers and housing makers are turning their attention to investing in Indonesia. The Japanese government has also invested in 3 cases already, about 12 billion yen, through JOIN, a government-affiliated company, to support the movement of active private enterprises in such urban development and housing fields.

(Reference: BSD Mitsubishi Corporation (approximately 3.4 billion yen), Second Aeon store (approximately 5 billion yen), Daiwa House (approximately 3 billion yen))

In addition to the above, we also invested in freezer warehouse (approximately 900 million yen).

In this forum, we focus on high-quality "building ability" of Japan, (1) sustainable / green building accompanying global warming countermeasure, (2) urban development in transport hub (TOD), (3) urban type housing complex in a project promoted by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, we will share the details of how we actually proceeded, and we'll have a discussion on how the Indonesian housing and urban development should be in the future.

I am praying that today's seminar triggers the exchange of opinions and mutual exchange among architects, leading to high quality housing and urban development result in Indonesia.

Last but not least, I believe that today's seminar was realized and brought here by efforts of the concerned parties with the support of everyone in Indonesia. I wish to express my gratitude to pray for the further development of this great country, and strengthening of bilateral relations of Indonesia and Japan.
